KITCHENER-WATERLOO SYMPHONY YOUTH ORCHESTRA MEMBERS RECEIVE  
TOP SCHOLARSHIPS DURING FINAL CONCERT OF SEASON

KITCHENER, Ontario – on April 12, 2008 the Kitchener-Waterloo Symphony's Youth Orchestra Program (YOP) will award 43 of its members with scholarships for outstanding music achievement. A total of \$14,550, given to those deserving players to help with the cost of their music education, is the greatest amount of scholarship funding in the history of the program. The Scholarship Awards Ceremony takes place during the final concert of the season, *Heroic Beethoven*. The concert will feature two works by Beethoven, *Egmont Overture* and "The Eroica", Mozart's *Allegro di molto*, KWS section violist David Wadley's *Three Movements for Younger Strings* and many others. The event takes place in the Centre In The Square (CITS), Kitchener at 2:00pm.

The KW Symphony Youth Orchestra Program comprised of four separate ensembles; Youth Strings, Youth Sinfonia, Youth Orchestra and Valhalla Brass, features outstanding soloists **Shirley Chen**, piano, and **Nick Bartlett**, French horn, who are also winners of the Youth Orchestra Concerto Competition. **Danielle Johannes**, principal oboe player for the Youth Orchestra, and another winner of the Youth Orchestra Concerto Competition, has also been accepted into the [National Youth Orchestra of Canada](#) and will begin training with the elite organization this summer.

The Kitchener-Waterloo Symphony is very proud of its dedicated and talented young musicians who contribute towards the cultural enrichment of their community and congratulates them on their remarkable achievements.
